TE Amy Loving Austin (Seneca #9 and Bellona, Memorial), Stated Clerk, offered acknowledgement of the first stewards of the land where we live and serve.

JUNIUS PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH ADMINISTRATIVE COMMISSION
